### *House Rules*

1. Customers' must be 18 years of age or older to be seated in their vehicle. Picture I.D. is required.
2. No building Admittance if not wearing a shirt, shoes or mask.
3. All packages and payouts are in Canadian currency only.
4. Social distancing is in effect and must be adhered to. Only members of the same household may occupy the same motor vehicle. You cannot leave your vehicle unless needing to use the washrooms. No food or beverages will be sold or provided at the event.
5. Wins are limited to one winning pattern per bingo card face.
6. No splitting, cutting or sharing of any bingo package. Bingos on split books/cards will not be honoured.
7. Bingo package can only be played at the session they were purchased from. They must not be used at any other bingo sessions.
8. Every effort will be made to prevent duplicate cards; in the unlikely event of a duplicate winning card, prizes will be divided equally among all valid winning cards,
9. Management reserves the right to refuse admittance and/or sales of any parking lot bingo packages.
10. Dabbers must be used on your bingo paper for bingo to be recognized.
11. The ball is not in play until the caller has verbally announced the number.
12. It is the player's responsibility to honk their horn on their vehicle and flash their headlights to ensure that the parking lot attendants hear your BINGO and stop the game. **Please honk loud and clear.**
13. A missed bingo after it has been closed will not be honoured.
14. Once a game is closed, it cannot be re-opened, unless the closed bingo is deemed to be invalid.
15. Multiple claims will share the prize money equally to a minimum of \$5 each.
16. Prizes will ONLY be paid to the winning player(s).
17. The conduct of the bingo event is regulated by the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario and managed by the Ontario Lottery and Gaming Corporation.
18. Management/Sponsors are not responsible for lost, damaged or stolen articles.
19. Management reserves the right to refuse entry into the building and parking lot.
20. Premises are under Surveillance.
21. All prizes valued at \$1,000 or more are subject to a Family Responsibility Office (FRO) check. Proper government issued identification is required to claim the prize.
22. Violation of the House Rules and/or Rules for Bingo Games and/or Government Regulations may result in a player not being awarded the prize.
23. The following individuals are not permitted access to the Charitable Gaming Centre: individuals who appear intoxicated; those restricted from accessing the gaming property or playing a lottery scheme as a condition of a court order; those have been excluded from the site under subsection 3.6(1) of the Gaming Control Act as noted by the registrar of the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario.
